COloRectal Resection ESCP Audit – CORREA: Extension of data entry period

On behalf of the European Society of Coloproctology (ESCP) Cohort Studies and Audits Committee and the CORREA management please accept this letter as confirmation that the rolling start period for data collection has been extended from 31st March 2022 to 30th April 2022.

The reason for the extension is to accommodate centres experiencing difficulties or delays in obtaining approvals to participate.

On commencing data collection on any day up to 30th April 2022 sites will contribute six weeks of continuous data, followed by a 30-day patient follow-up period.

CORREA is supported by the ESCP and will be coordinated by the Birmingham Centre for Observational and Prospective Studies, part of the University of Birmingham.
